

ByLaws Updates

Recently, the Board of Directors has made some updates to the Club's ByLaws. We wish to share these with you here:

1. The position of Facilities Coordinator will become a voting member of the Board and as such, will be known as the Facilities Director. This will be effective January 1, 2026.
2. In the event a suitable candidate for Commodore with at least one year of service on the Board cannot be found to fulfill this position, then under these special circumstances, the Board may consider a candidate who is a member in good standing with at least 3 years membership who may be nominated subject to Board approval.
3. Lifetime Memberships can be bestowed by way of a majority vote of the Board at a regular Board meeting. The maximum number of Lifetime Memberships are not to exceed five 5 memberships.
