*Saturday, July 19th*

- ◆ **Departure Location:** A Dock – Next to the Loch Lomond Yacht Club at the Safe Harbor Loch Lomond Marina.
- ◆ **Cost:** Free for members, but \$20.00 berth fee per boat at Angel Island; please donate to your captain to cover this cost.
- ◆ **Lunch:** Potluck Style: each family should bring lunch items to share with the group.
- ◆ **9-10am** - Boats get ready at Loch Lomond Marina
- ◆ **10am-12pm** - Everyone sails to Angel Island where we moor our boats at the Marina. The \$20 boat fee is payable to the Park Ranger at the Marina entrance. Skippers will receive a sticker to put on your boat while in the Marina.
- ◆ **12-1:30pm** – Potluck Lunch will start at the Park near the Marina.
- ◆ **1:30-3 or 4pm** – Sail back to Loch Lomond Marina. Depending on wind and weather, this may take 1-3 hours.


